Rag Bag

The Rag Bag collection has been ongoing now for over twelve months and has proven to be a very successful and easy way to raise funds for school. The bin is located outside just opposite the Library and is emptied regularly. Parents can donate old clothes and shoes and leave them at school reception in a bag/bin liner or (out of school hours) placed directly into the bin. Once full, the bin is emptied and school is paid for the “Rags” by the kilo. On average the bin generates between £25 and £35 each time it is emptied. It literally is a way to make money from rags!

A big thank you to all of you that have donated so far and continue to donate in this way. Keep on bagging up – why not have a clear out before Christmas and make room for new clothes for the new season?
