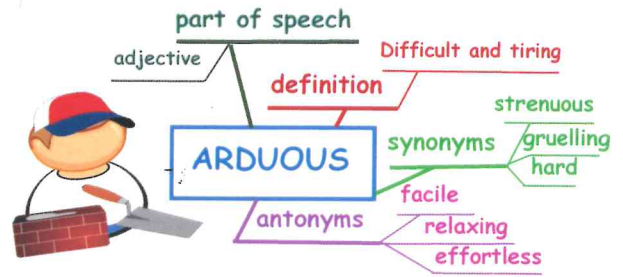
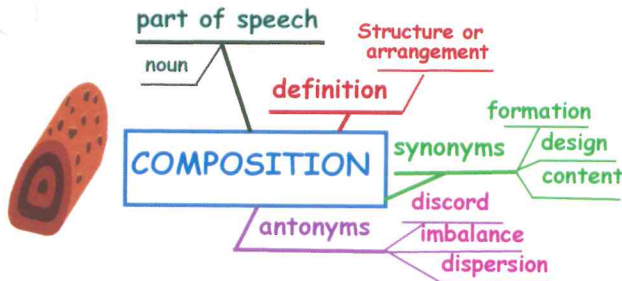


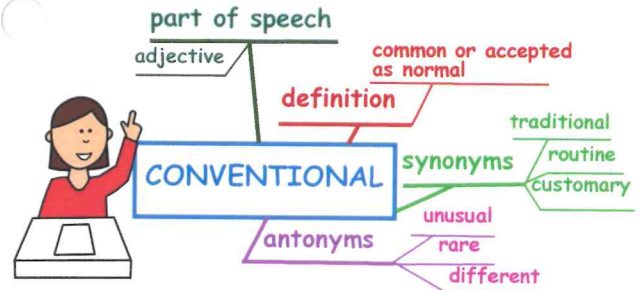
EXAMPLE: Edward had a **bewildered** expression because he couldn't work out which way to go.



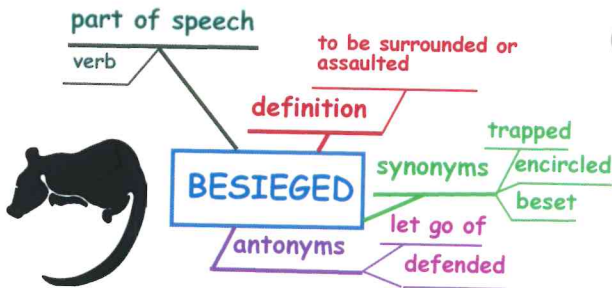
EXAMPLE: Building a brick wall is an **arduous** task.



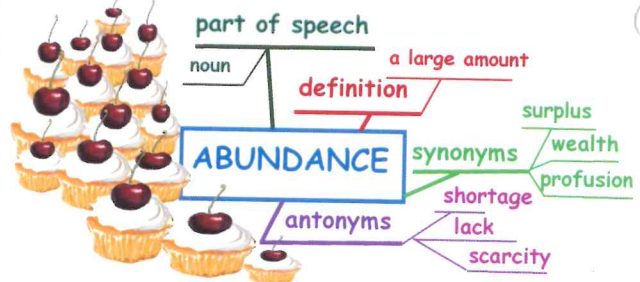
EXAMPLE: Chocolate log has a **composition** of flour, eggs sugar and chocolate.



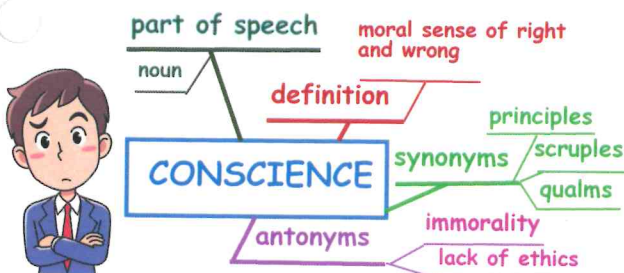
EXAMPLE: Shouting and interrupting is not **conventional** behaviour in a classroom.



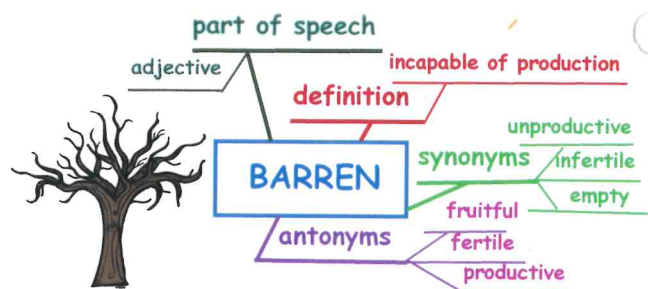
EXAMPLE: One hundred rats **besieged** Tom's cat, and he fled.
