




Example: Mrs Long was very impressed with the meticulous arrangement of books and pens on every table.




Example: Loud music from her neighbour's party became a nuisance at 3am.




Example: The teacher had peculiar habits; one idiosyncrasy was to touch his ear when listening.




Example: Dilapidated buildings are the result of neglect.
