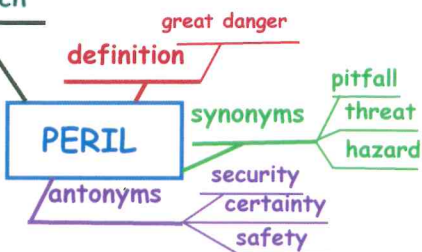

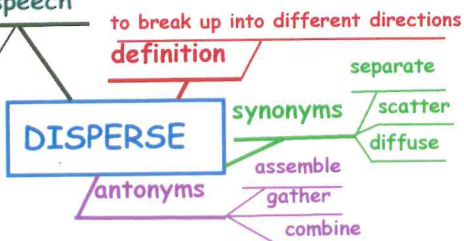

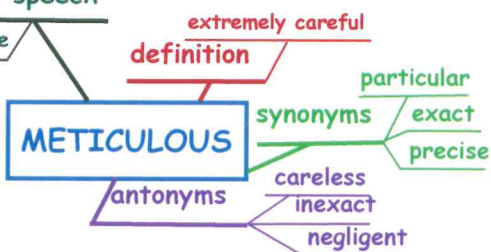


Example: The team decided to **disperse** in different directions to have a better chance of finding the treasure.

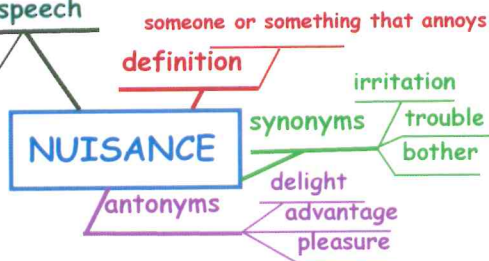


Example: Mrs Long was very impressed with the **meticulous** arrangement of books and pens on every table.

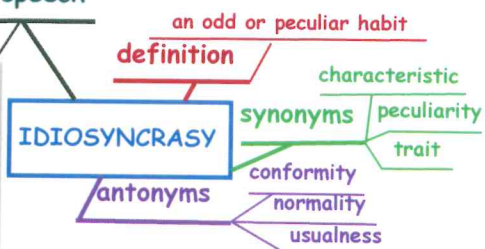

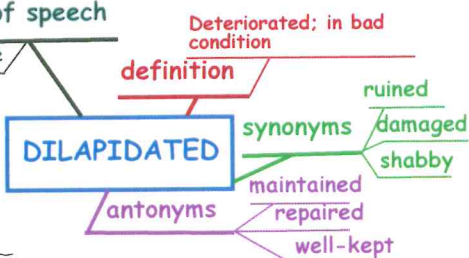
